Technical Bulletins

The TTB had a rules clarification regarding roll bars and the wording used around the need/usage of backing plates and other mounting options in Safety Level 2.2.1.L-O

The TTB is working on updating this language for clarity. The current wording is there to allow many types
of installs, including those that bolt in and are welded in (whether using a mounting plate or boxed in
structure). The TTB reminds all that these requirements are there for when a Safety Level 2 roll bar is
required.

Parts Approvals

- Request to allow SuperPro Alloy Front Lower Control Arms for VW cars.
 - The inclusion of a spherical joint within the control arm is not legal for Tuner at this time. The TTB will continue to assess the situation going into 2025.
