Nankang CR-1 Tire:

There has been some questions about eligibility, but the TTB has determined the Nankang CR-1 is eligible for Sport, Tuner and Max Category Competition for 2021.

Clarifications

Aftermarket Hard Top Allowance in Tuner Category:

The TTB would like to reinforce the allowance for aftermarket hard tops in "*Tuner Category Interior and Bodywork 2.2.2.* Vehicles with removable hardtops may use an exact replica hard top including one made of alternate materials" is only for replacement of OE hard tops.

Convertibles/Targa-tops without an OE hard top may not use an aftermarket hard top, and the allowance does not allow replacing a soft top with alternate materials.

Multiple Vehicles used for a single class/event entry:

The TTB would like to point out that while there is no specific rule about a single car having to be run the entire event at this time, the general expected intent is for the same vehicle to be run. Car changes should not be planned as event strategy and any changes should be due to hardship cases and will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis by event officials.
