

## TTB Meeting Minutes – March 15th, 2023

The TTB met via zoom: Present were Staff members John Hunter and Justin Barbry, BoD liaisons Clay Turner and Charlie Davis, and members at large Doug Wille, and Brian Kuehl. Also present were Kathy Barnes and Ryan Cheek.

## **Member Advisories**

There are no items out for comment at this time.

### **Technical Bulletins**

The TTB had a rules clarification regarding the removal of sunroofs/moonroofs when implementing Safety Level 2. The TTB feels the removal of sunroofs and moonroofs to facilitate the installation of a rollbar has always been the intent, and has added language to the rule to clarify this. They have also re-organized the section to add some clarity. The section can be found in Sport Category Interior – Full Rules:

- **9.** With the addition of Safety equipement, the following allowances apply:
  - **A.** If the vehicle is equipped with at least a 4-point roll bar, driver's seat, and restraints meeting SCCA Time Trials Safety Level 2 Standards:
    - **1.** Rear seats carpet and trim behind the seats may be removed.
    - **2.** Sunroofs, moonroofs, and similar roof-mounted panel cartridges may be replaced by an alternate solid panel serving no other purpose. Attachment is unrestricted but must be secure.
    - **3.** Airbags may be removed.
    - **4.** Airbag-equiped steering wheels may be replaced or have the airbag removed.

- **5.** Convertible soft tops and related structure and brackets may be removed.
- **B.** If the vehicle is equipped with a minimum 6-point roll cage, driver's seat and restraints meeting SCCA Time Trials Safety Level 3 Standards, all interior carpet, trim and passenger seats other than the factory dash may be removed.

The TTB was asked to clarify the Sport category rule that states bump stops may be substituted or modified, provided they are in the same location as stock. The question was whether shocks supplied with internal bump stops may be used. Many of the shocks which fall under the overall Sport Class rules include internal bump stops, thus the TTB has add the following clarification:

**6.** Bump stops may be substituted or modified, provided they are in the same location as stock. (Shocks/struts with an internal bump stop on the shock shaft meet this requirement.)

The TTB was also asked to clarify the rules around Max aero and using Wings and Spoilers together. It is the TTB feeling that this rule is centered around aftermarket additions, and has clarified the rule as such:

**I.** Aftermarket Spoilers and aftermarket rear wings are mutually exclusive such that a builder may add one or the other, but not both.
