TTB Meeting Minutes – February, 2024

The TTB met via zoom: Present were Staff members John Hunter and Justin Barbry, BoD liaison David Vodden and members at large Gregg Ginsberg, Brian Kuehl, and Bob Tunnell.

Member Advisories

There are no Member Advisories at this time.

Technical Bulletins

The TTB had a rules clarification regarding allowances for removing the metal speaker box in the rear of the Nissan 350Z when installing a roll cage and running in Max.

- The TTB believes that the removal of this structure is more in line with Unlimited than with Max, Tuner or Sport.

The TTB received a rules clarification regarding upgraded hubs for cars such as the NA and NB Miata's running in Tuner.

- The TTB believes that while this is not currently within the intent of the Tuner rules, it is worth further consideration. This has been added to the docket for further consideration going into the 2025 rules "Unfreezing".

The TTB received a rules clarification regarding the allowance of installing reinforcing gussets to pre-emptively reinforce portions of the subframe/control arm pivots on NA and NB Miata's running in Tuner.

- The TTB believes these gussets are not within intent of the Tuner rule set. Bolt on lateral reinforcement braces are ok, should they meet the rest of the Tuner ruleset.

The TTB received a rules clarification on the word "Nominal" regarding rule 4. Tuner Category – Brakes 1.1. Non-Standard brake rotors may be used provided they are of equal or larger dimensions. *Nominal* reductions in rotor thickness or diameter in common big brake kits are permitted. The specific situation in question was the installation of 380mm rotors on the BMW M2, when it came with 400mm from the factory.

- As a result of this request, the TTB had a discussion around the word nominal. This will be addressed in the 2025 ruleset for Tuner. However, there will be no action at this time.
